Archives in the Neighbourhood! Movie Poster Conservation

June 8- June 16

Come watch and talk with City of Vancouver Archives conservators as they piece together the huge 1924 movie poster, *Western Luck*, at the Moberly Arts and Cultural Centre. This poster was discovered in the Orpheum Theatre during renovations in the 1980s and offers a glimpse into 'pop culture' in Vancouver in the 1920s.
